The Project Officer position is the entry point of a three-tier career development pathway within the Policy and Advocacy Team, offering growth opportunities for motivated and mission-aligned professionals.

Your main tasks include:

- Support knowledge development: Conduct desk research and analysis on the policy, business and investment enabling environment to support evidence-based advocacy activities. These include insights on relevant policy frameworks for agroecology, agroecological entrepreneurship and investment trends.
- Support evidence dissemination & sensitization: Develop, update and promote key knowledge and advocacy products, including tools, case studies, and target audience focused communication materials.
- Conduct networking & sensitization activities among public and private actors in the policy and financier communities in the field of agriculture & food systems.
- Support/lead the coordination and organization of national, regional and international policy and investment related events, including roundtables, multistakeholder dialogues, conferences, and highlevel meetings.
